

Number of Individuals with Criminal Convictions Sealed via CPL 160.59

(Under a provision of the state's Raise the Age law, effective Oct. 7, 2017)

New York State Criminal Procedure Law (Section 160.59) permits individuals who have remained crime-free for 10 years to request that certain New York State convictions be sealed. The law allows eligible individuals to petition the court to seal up to two misdemeanor convictions; one misdemeanor and one felony conviction; or one felony conviction.

This table, which will be updated monthly, details the number of individuals who successfully petitioned a court to have a case(s) sealed, by month and county in which the seal was granted. If an individual has had cases sealed in multiple counties, this table lists the individual in the county and month where and when the first seal was granted.
