

2012 Dispositions of Felony and Misdemeanor Arrests of Penal Law Charges by Age Group, Gender, and County

Data Notes

These tables are a supplemental reference for applicants responding to the 2013 Alternatives to Incarceration Request for Proposals from the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS). DCJS expects that applicants will propose programs within areas with a demonstrated need for services. These data are for use by applicants who may seek to serve special populations, such as people under 25, to demonstrate that sufficient numbers fall within their proposed geographic area.

The data presented in this table are from the Computerized Criminal History (CCH) system (data as of 5/21/2013) maintained by DCJS. CCH includes adult arrests for fingerprintable offenses (ages 16 and older; and juvenile offenders prosecuted in the adult courts) and the dispositions of those arrests. Vehicle Traffic Law related arrests and violation level arrests are excluded from this table.

The data presented in this table show dispositions resulted from felony or misdemeanor arrests. All dispositions are from 2012, although the arrest could have occurred in a prior year. The table provides a summary of the demographic distribution (age and gender) of the dispositions within each county.

All dispositions, including dismissals, acquittals, and declines to prosecute are counted in this table. The percentages shown represent the proportion of total final dispositions reported in 2012.

Above is an excerpt from the disposition demographics table. It shows Bronx County had 71,479 dispositions in 2012 from felony or misdemeanor arrests. Specifically, there were 19,329 felony arrests disposed and 52,150 misdemeanor arrests disposed in 2012 for Bronx. Among the dispositions of felony arrest, 38% of them involved individuals younger than 25 years old, and 84% of felony defendants were male; in addition, 40% of the dispositions from misdemeanor arrests had defendants under 25 and 81% of defendants were male.
