The Chair then requested a motion to approve the minutes of the August 3, 2018 DNA Subcommittee meeting. The first item concerning accreditation was related to the reaccreditation of Erie County Central Police Services. The subcommittee reviewed documents related to the reaccreditation of the laboratory. Dr. Sozer made a motion to issue a binding recommendation to the Commission on Forensic Science to renew the laboratory's New York State accreditation in the discipline of Biology for the period concurrent with their ANAB accreditation. Dr. Kidd seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.
