

DCJS ANNOUNCES WINNING BIDDER in RFP CJS 2007-03

The New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS), an Executive Agency of the State of New York, announces that Sagem Morpho, Inc. of Tacoma, Washington has been selected by DCJS as the winning bidder in the DCJS procurement for a new Statewide Automated Biometric Identification System (SABIS), RFP number CJS 2007-03.

Take notice that the Restricted Period in this procurement continues until approval of the contract by the Office of the State Comptroller

Effective January 1, 2006, all Vendors and persons acting on their behalf who communicate or attempt to communicate with DCJS with respect to this procurement are subject to the requirements and restrictions set forth in Chapter 1 of the Laws of 2005, as amended by Chapter 596 of the Laws of 2005 (“the Procurement Lobbying Act”). The Restricted Period for this procurement commenced on May 1, 2008 and will continue until approval of a contract by the Comptroller of the State of New York. During the Restricted Period for this procurement, ALL communications must be only as directed by DCJS and only to the Designated Contact identified by DCJS. Violation of the Procurement Lobbying Law can result in penalties.
