2009 Drug Law Changes 2019 Annual Report

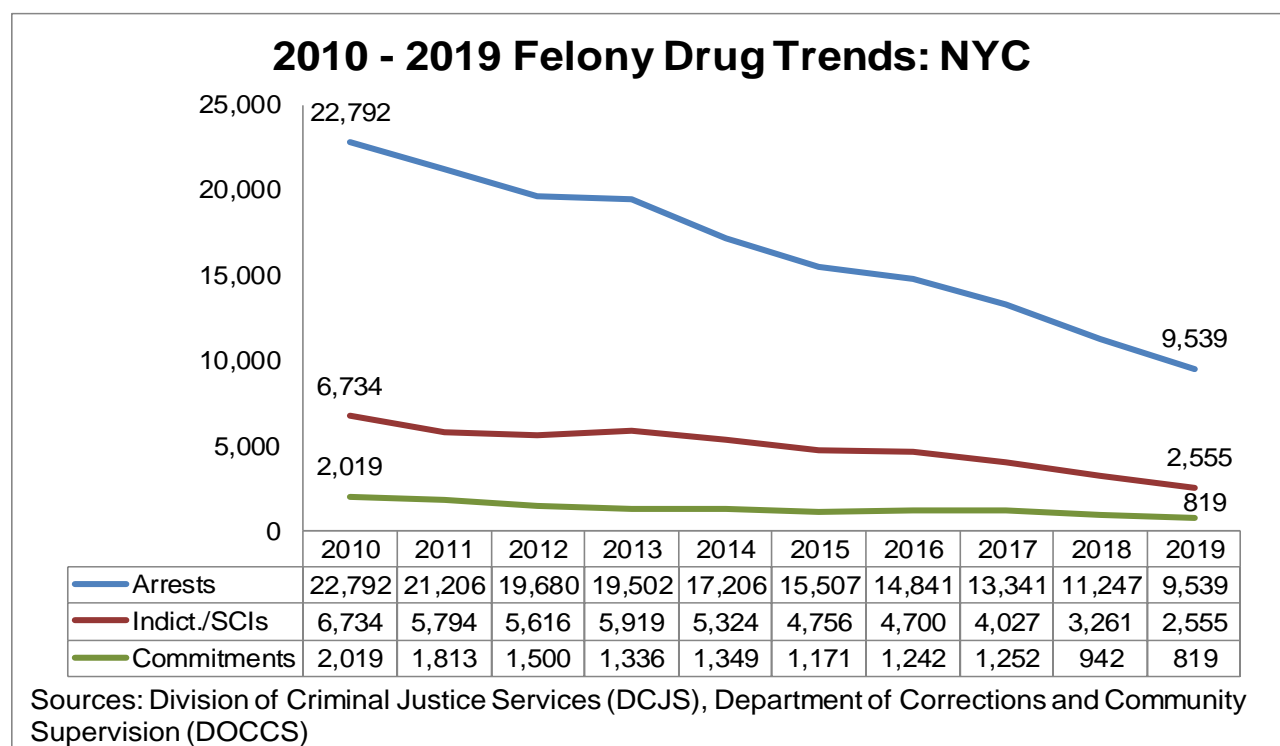
The 2009 reforms to New York's Rockefeller Drug Laws included a requirement to study the impact of these changes (see New York State Executive Law §837). This report details trends in arrests, indictments and superior court informations (SCIs); prison commitments; and screening and admission to felony drug court for felony drug and specified property offenses.¹ These data are reported to the state Division of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS) and state Department of Corrections and Community Supervision (DOCCS).

¹ Eligible property offenses include: third-degree burglary, second- and third-degree criminal mischief, third- and fourth-degree grand larceny (excluding firearms), third- and fourth-degree criminal possession of stolen property (excluding firearms), second-degree forgery, second-degree criminal possession of a forged instrument, second-degree unauthorized use of a motor vehicle, and first-degree unlawfully using slugs.

Felony Drug Arrests, Indictments, and Commitments

The charts below present trends in felony drug arrests, indictments and commitments in New York City, large counties outside of New York City² and small counties³ outside of New York City. In the five boroughs, felony drug arrests, indictments and commitments decreased dramatically from 2010 to 2019. In large counties outside of New York City, arrests declined annually from 2010 through 2015, increased in 2016 and 2017 and then declined again in 2018 and 2019. Meanwhile, indictments and commitments were more stable. In small counties outside of the five boroughs, felony drug arrests, indictments and commitments increased from 2010 to 2013 and then fluctuated from 2014 through 2019.

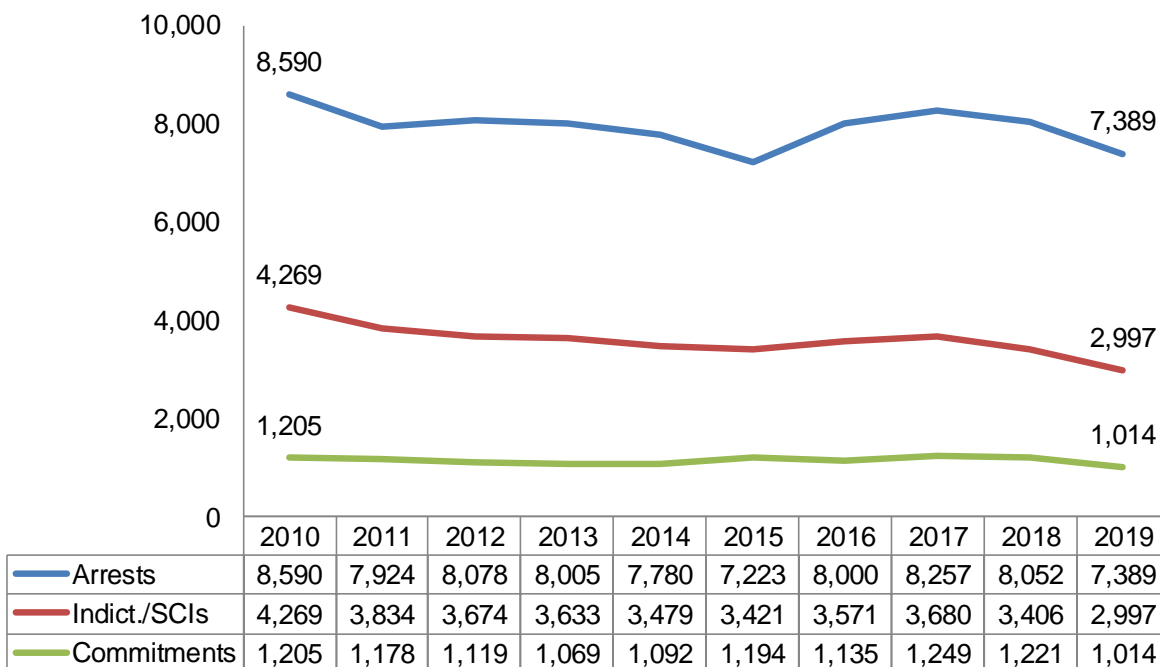

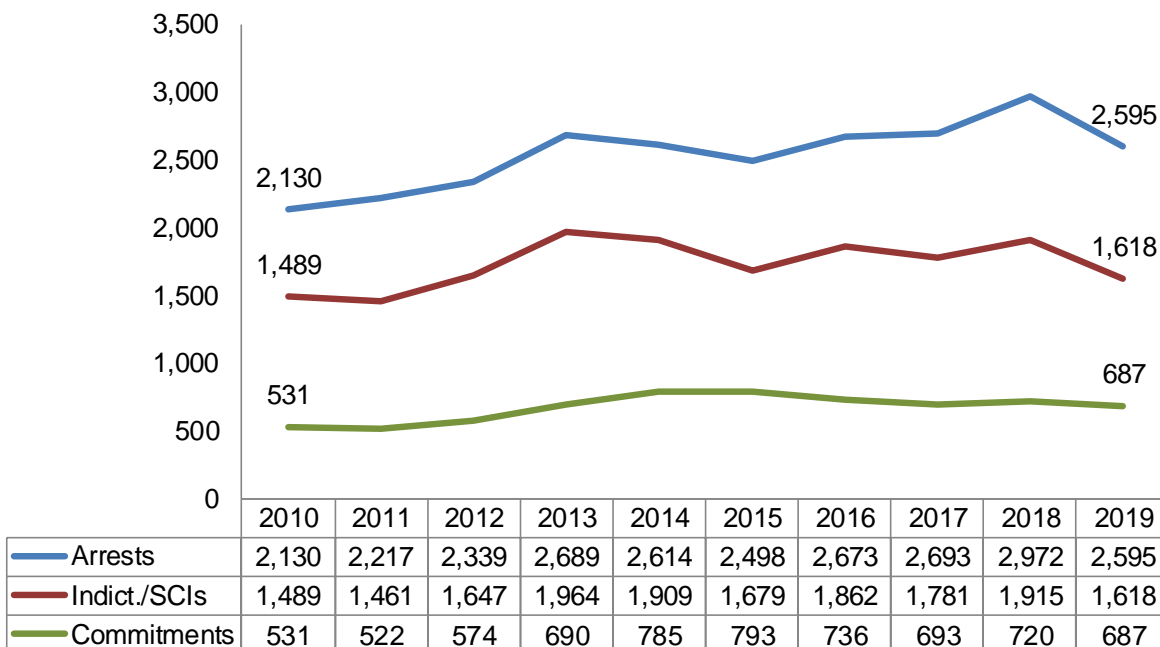

Individuals under Custody for Drug Crimes

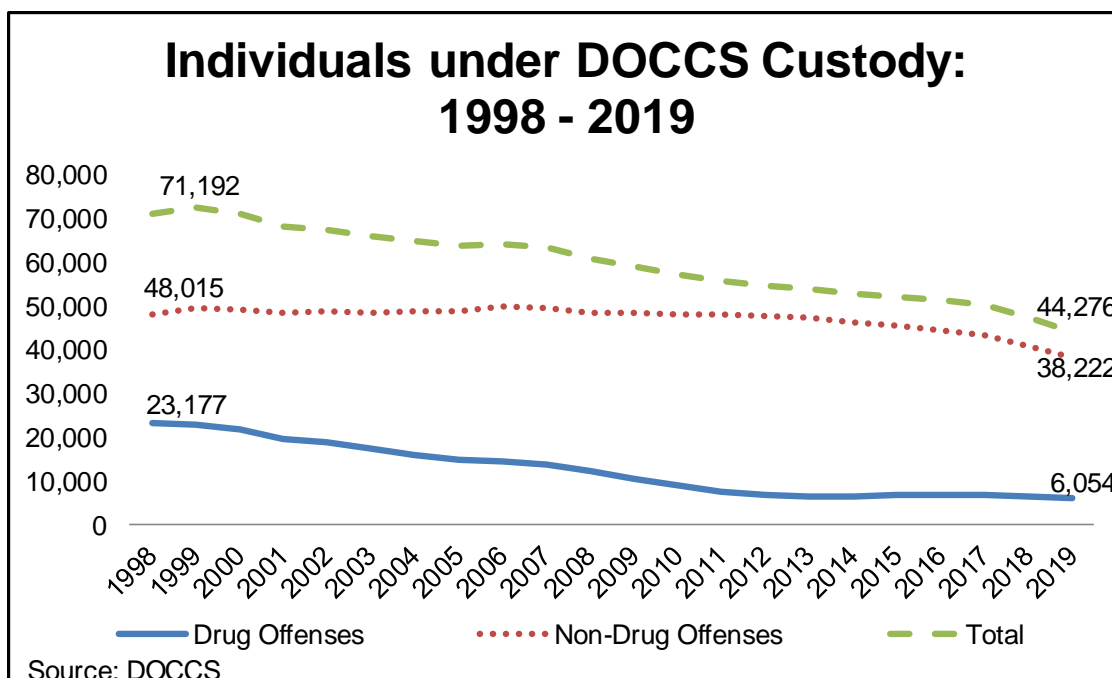
New York State's prison population peaked in 1999, with 72,649 individuals incarcerated. Over the following two decades, the population declined dramatically and is largely attributable to fewer individuals under custody for drug convictions.

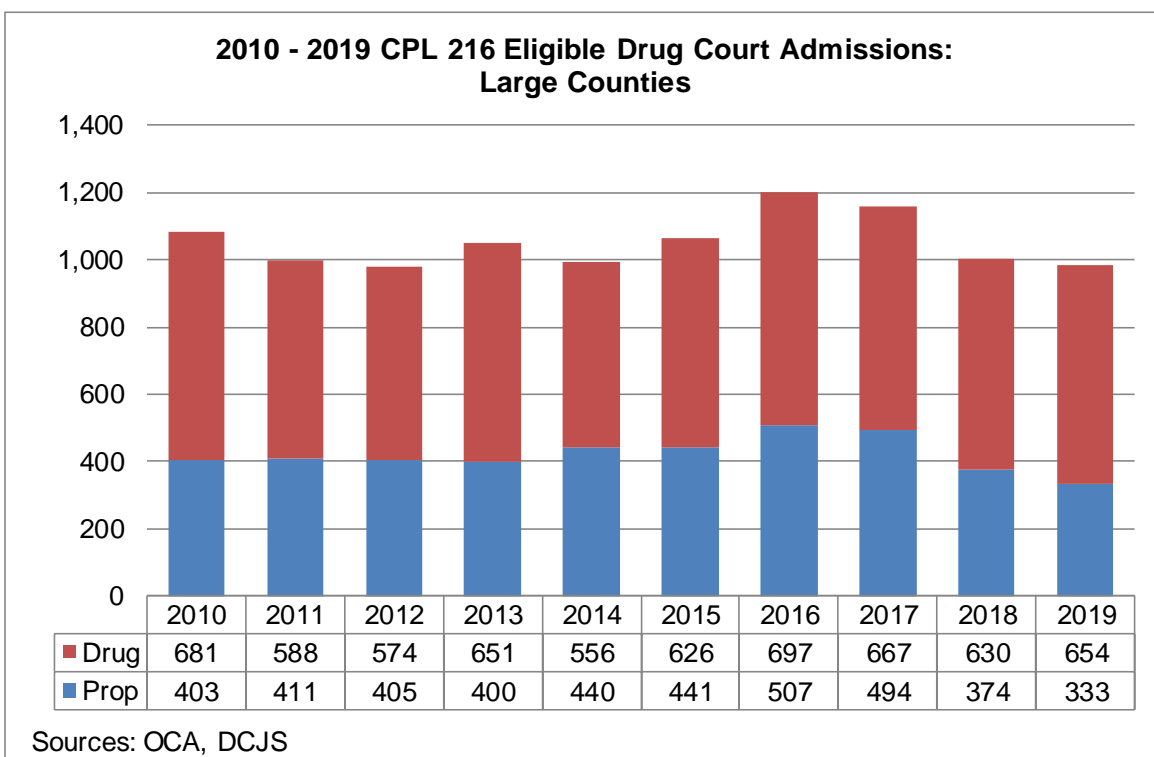
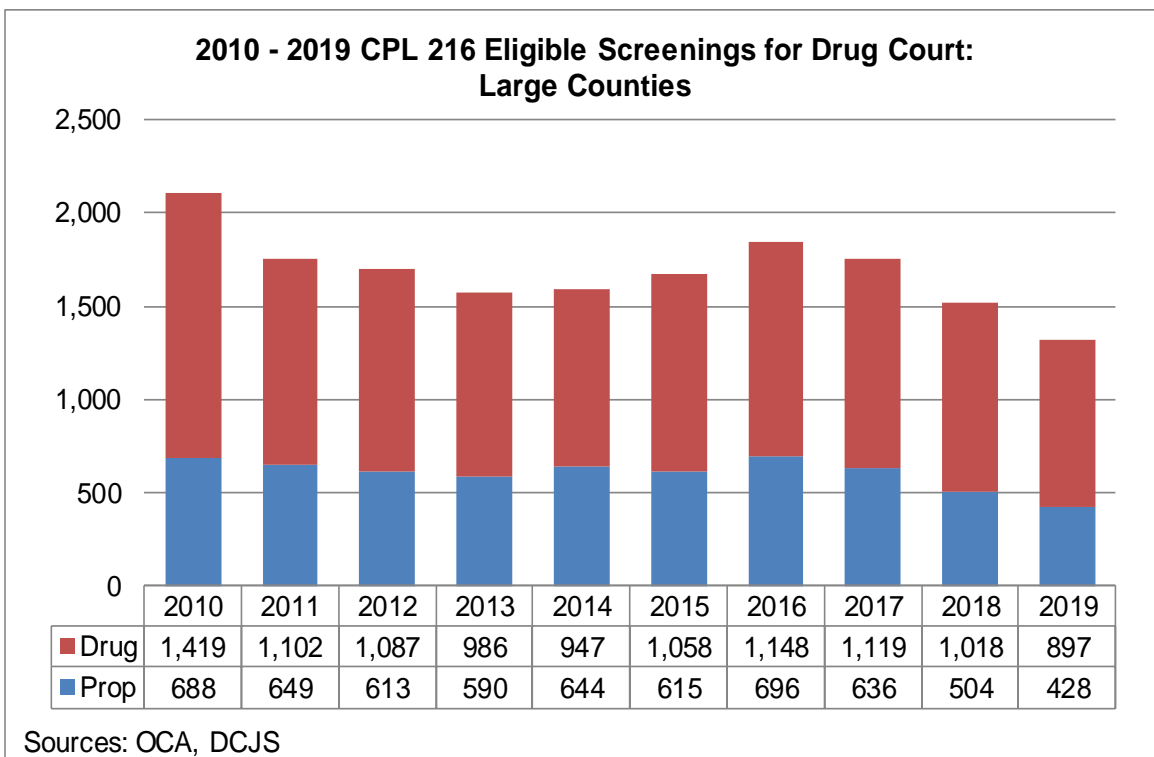


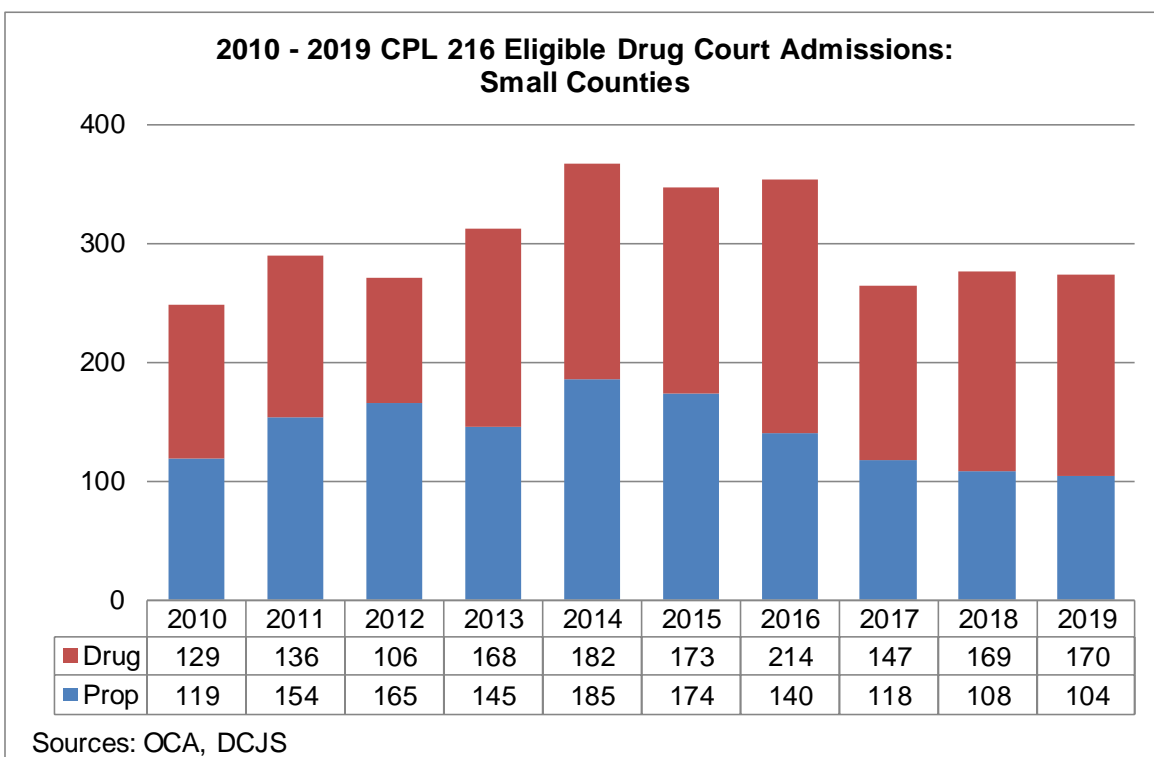
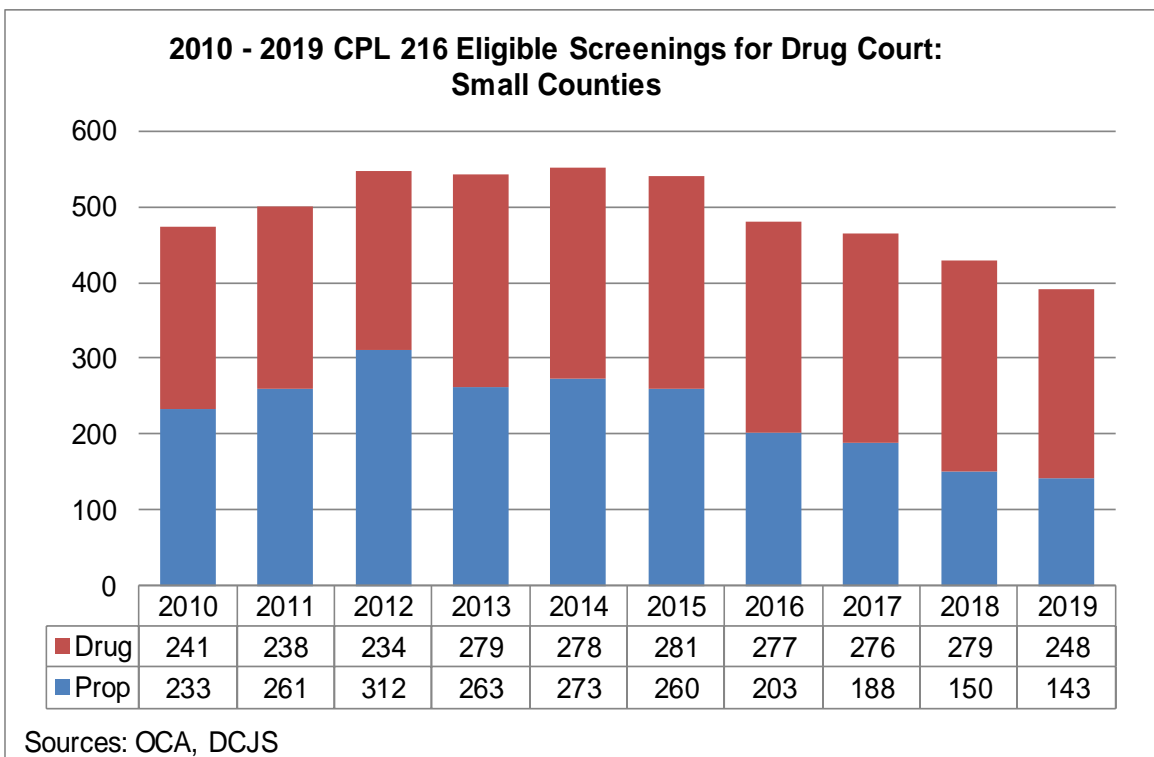
Criminal Procedure Law (CPL) Article 216: Judicial Diversion

The charts on pages 7, 8, and 9 detail screenings and admissions to felony drug court for individuals charged with drug and specified property offenses. In New York City, felony drug court screenings declined from 2010 to 2019, consistent with decreases in felony drug arrests. Felony drug court admissions peaked in 2010 and declined through 2019. In large counties outside of New York City, felony drug court screenings and admissions have remained relatively stable while in small counties outside of New York City, felony drug court screenings steadily increased from 2010 to 2015 before decreasing through 2019. Admissions in those small counties followed a similar trend. In May 2017, New York State opened its first court specifically to address opioid use; there are now 16 of those courts across the state. The data presented in the charts on pages 7, 8 and 9 include screenings and admissions to those courts.

Felony drug court screenings and admissions for arrests eligible for judicial diversion by county are presented in Appendix G and Appendix H.







Conditional Sealing

Criminal Procedure Law Section 160.58 authorizes conditional sealing of cases if individuals successfully complete court-ordered addiction treatment services. Under CPL 160.58 an individual can apply to the court to have their conviction conditionally sealed. However, if the individual is arrested again for a misdemeanor or felony, the case will be unsealed.

From 2010 through 2019, a total of 812 cases have been conditionally sealed. Most of the cases sealed (74.5%) were from courts in large counties outside of New York City.

The chart that follows shows a regional breakdown and cases sealed by county are detailed in Appendix I.
