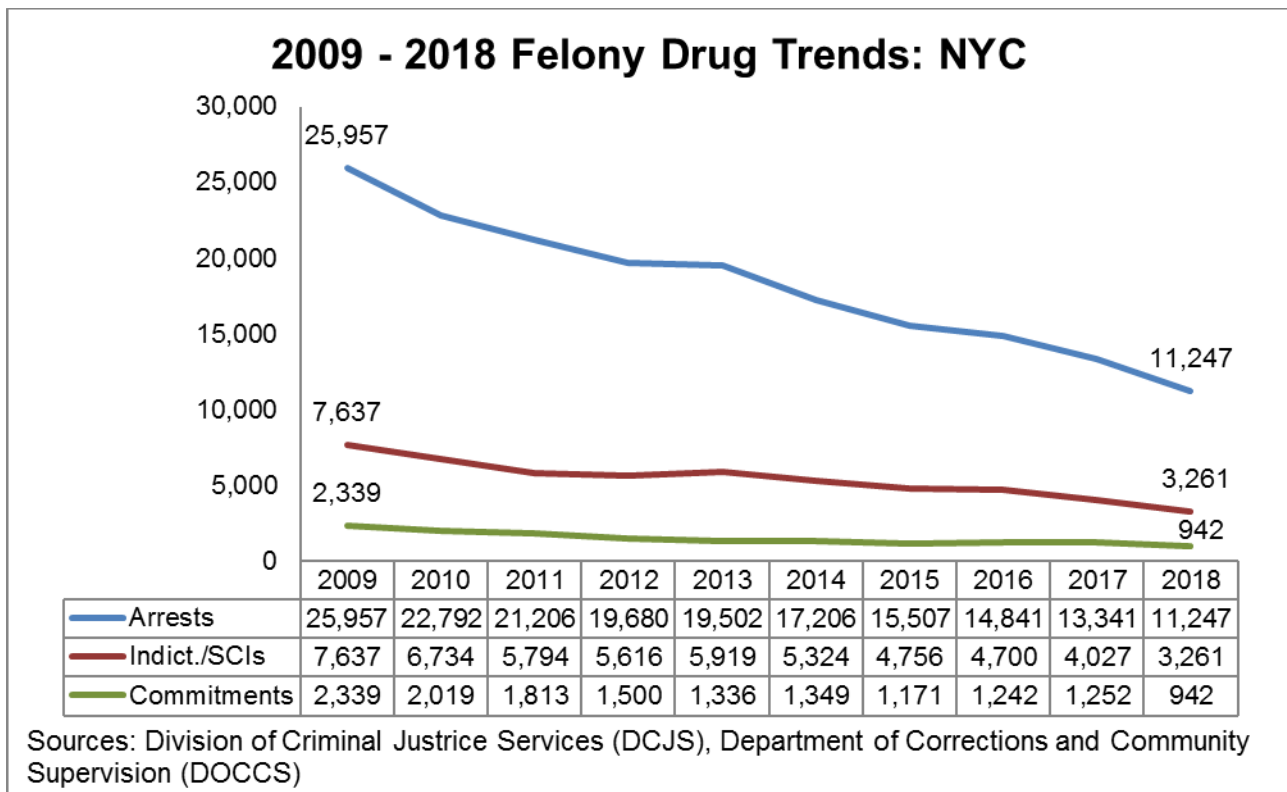

2009 Drug Law Changes 2017-2018 Report

The 2009 reforms to New York’s Rockefeller Drug Laws included a requirement to study the impact of these changes (see New York State Executive Law §837). This report details trends in arrests, indictments and superior court informations (SCIs), prison commitments and screening and admission to felony drug court for felony drug and specified property offenses.¹ Other reports on this topic are posted to the DCJS website: www.criminaljustice.ny.gov.

Felony Drug Arrests, Indictments, and Commitments

The charts below present trends in felony drug arrests, indictments, and commitments across New York City, large counties outside of NYC² and small counties outside of NYC.³ In New York City, felony drug arrests, indictments and commitments decreased dramatically from 2009 to 2018. In large counties outside of NYC, arrests declined through 2015 and then increased. Indictments and commitments were more stable. In small counties outside of NYC, felony drug arrests, indictments, and commitments generally increased from 2009 to 2018.

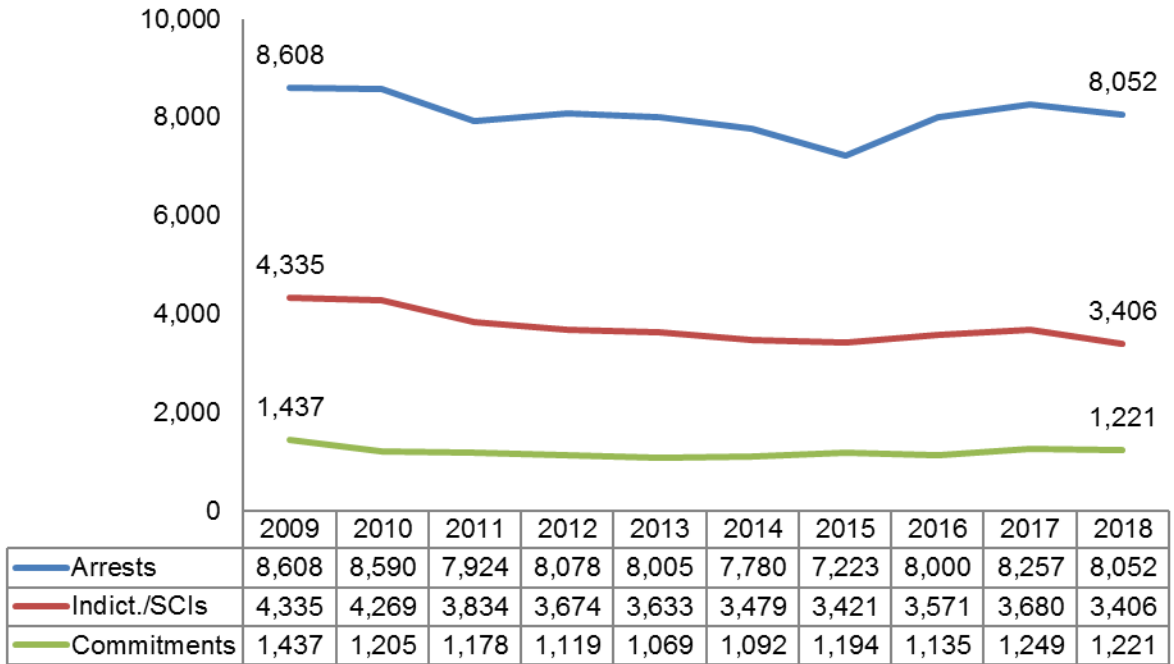


¹ Eligible property offenses include: third-degree burglary, second- and third-degree criminal mischief, third- and fourth-degree grand larceny (excluding firearms), third- and fourth-degree criminal possession of stolen property (excluding firearms), second-degree forgery, second-degree criminal possession of a forged instrument, second-degree unauthorized use of a motor vehicle, and first-degree unlawfully using slugs.

² Large counties outside NYC include: Albany, Broome, Chautauqua, Dutchess, Erie, Monroe, Nassau, Niagara, Oneida, Onondaga, Orange, Rensselaer, Rockland, Schenectady, Suffolk, Ulster, and Westchester.

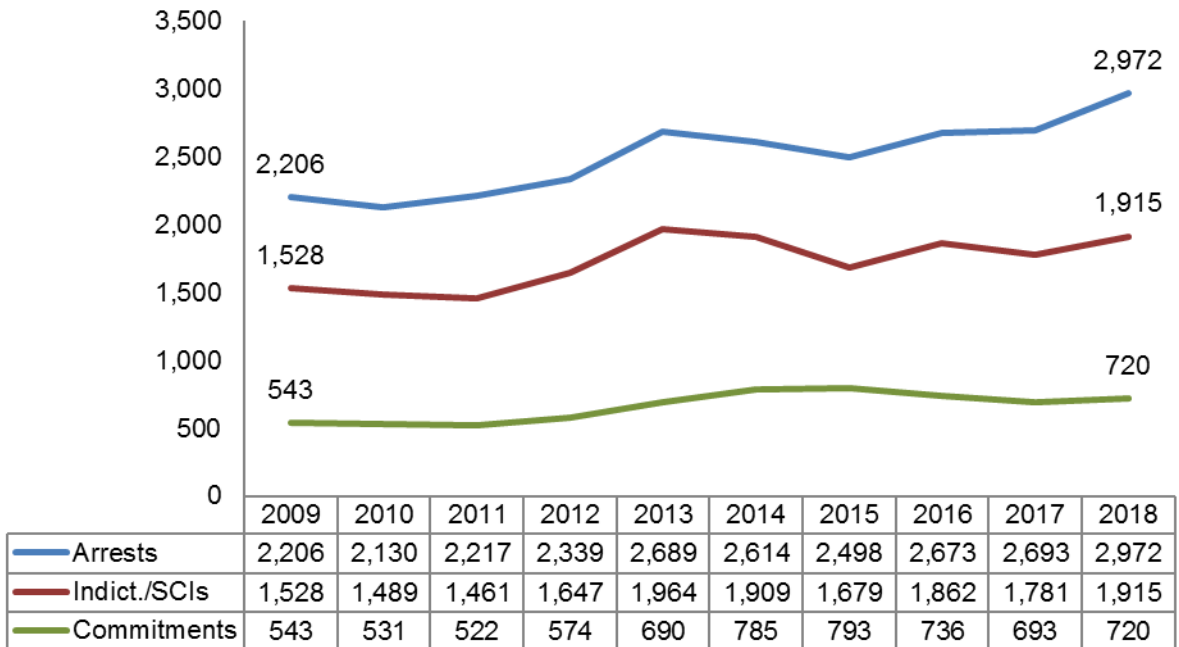

Drug Offenders under Custody

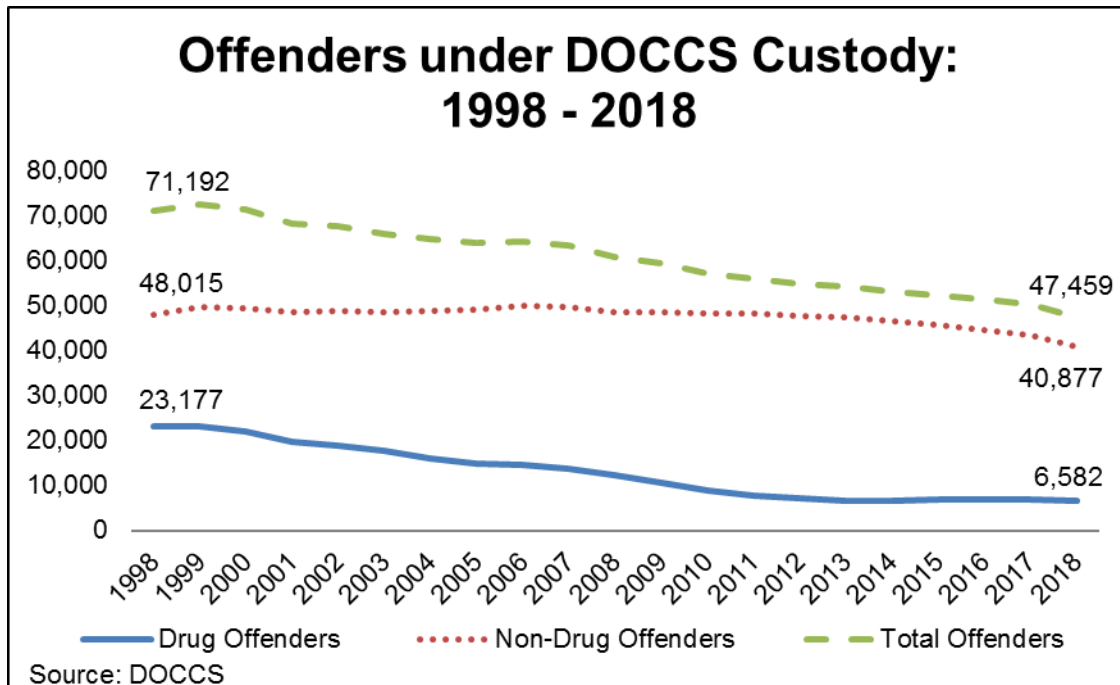
Over the past two decades, the decline in the total inmate population under custody is largely attributable to the decline in drug offenders under custody.

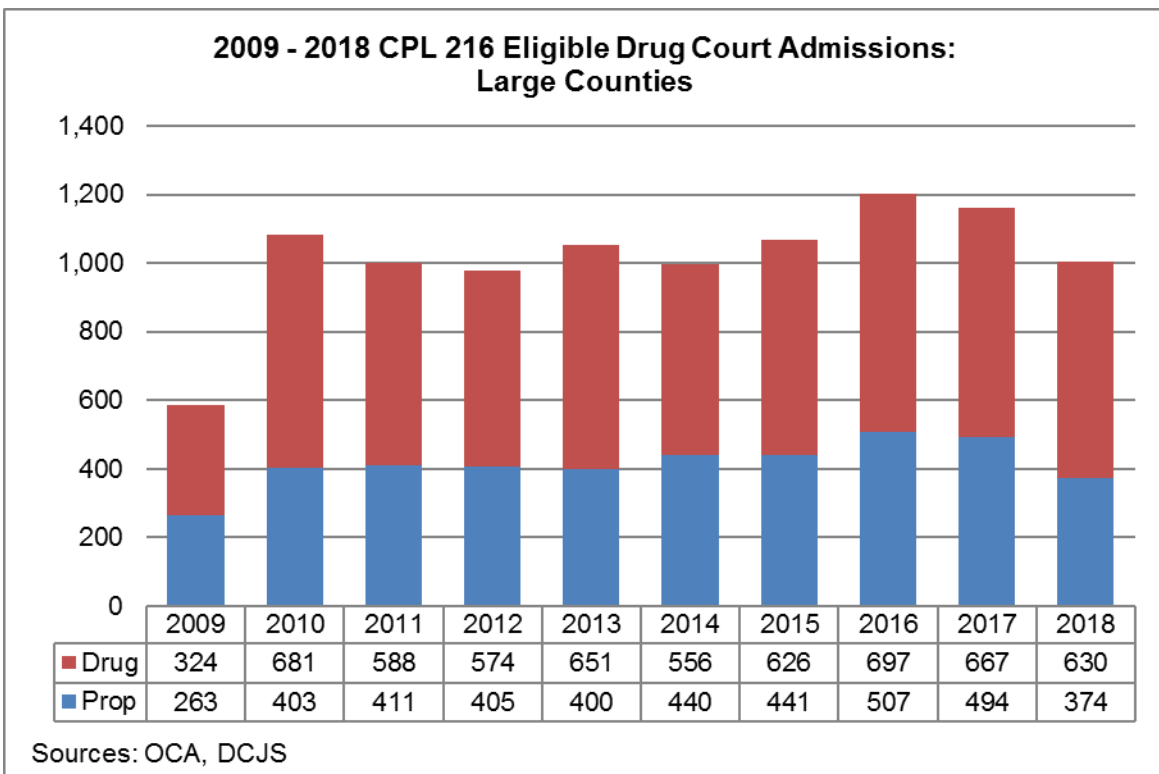
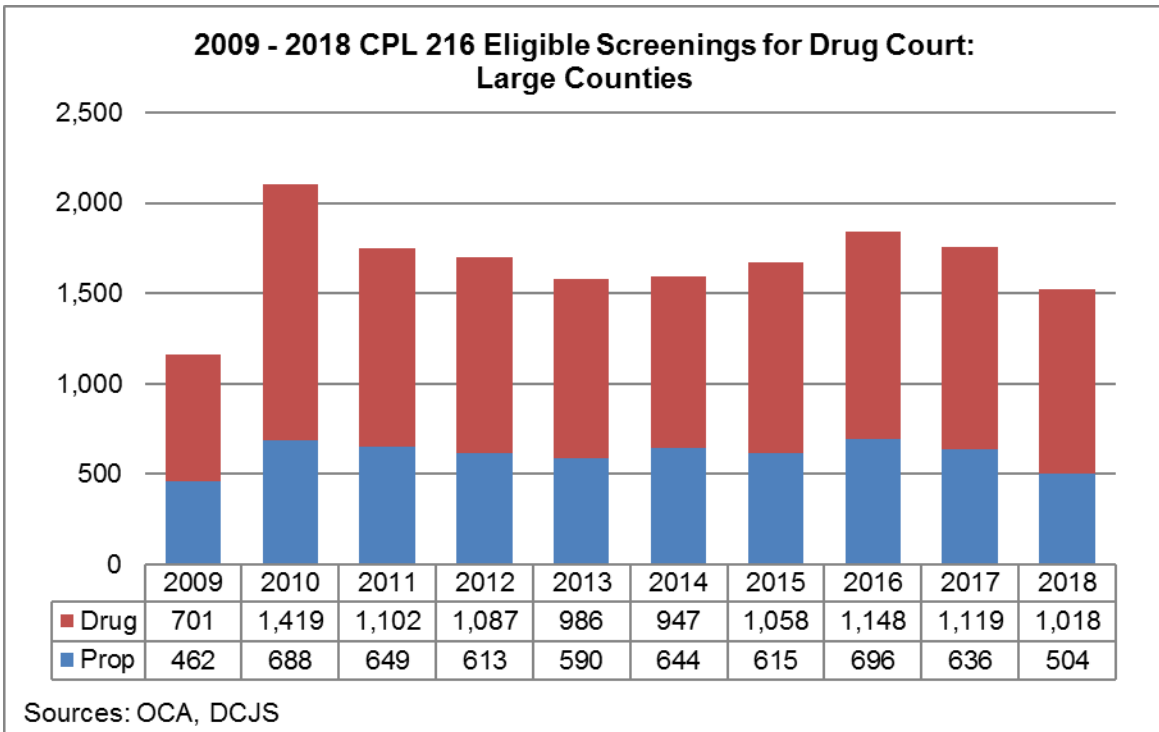


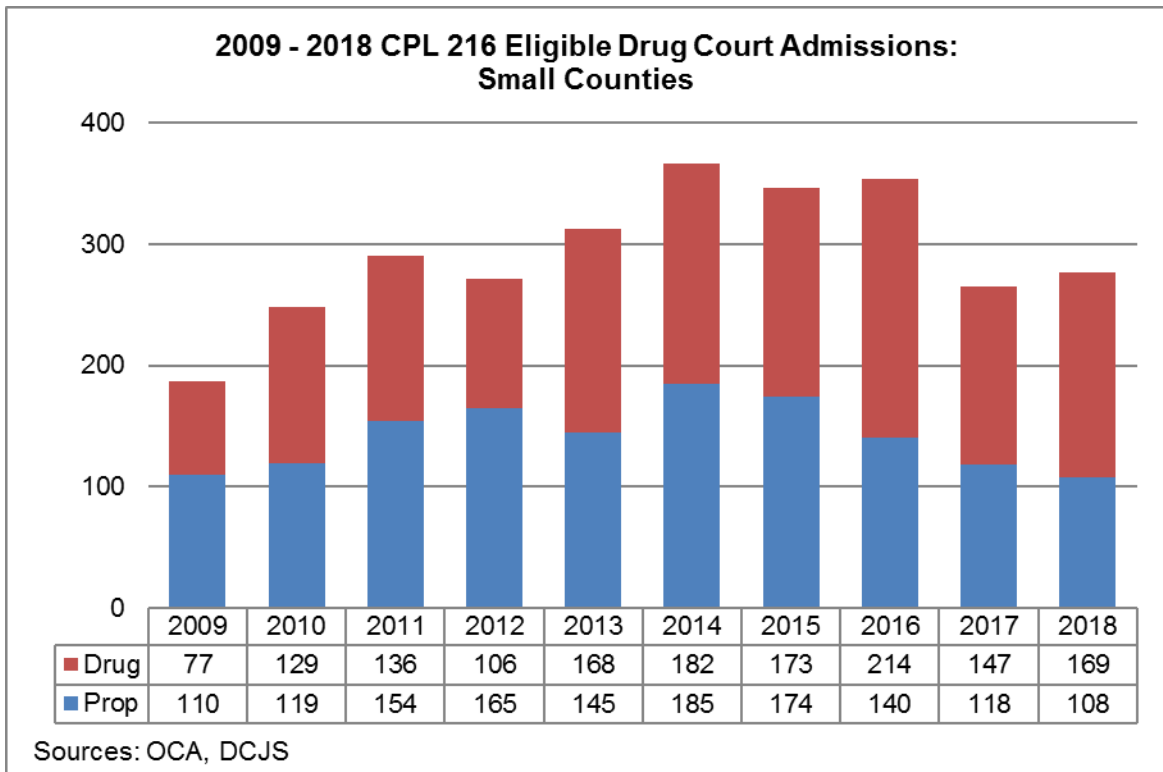
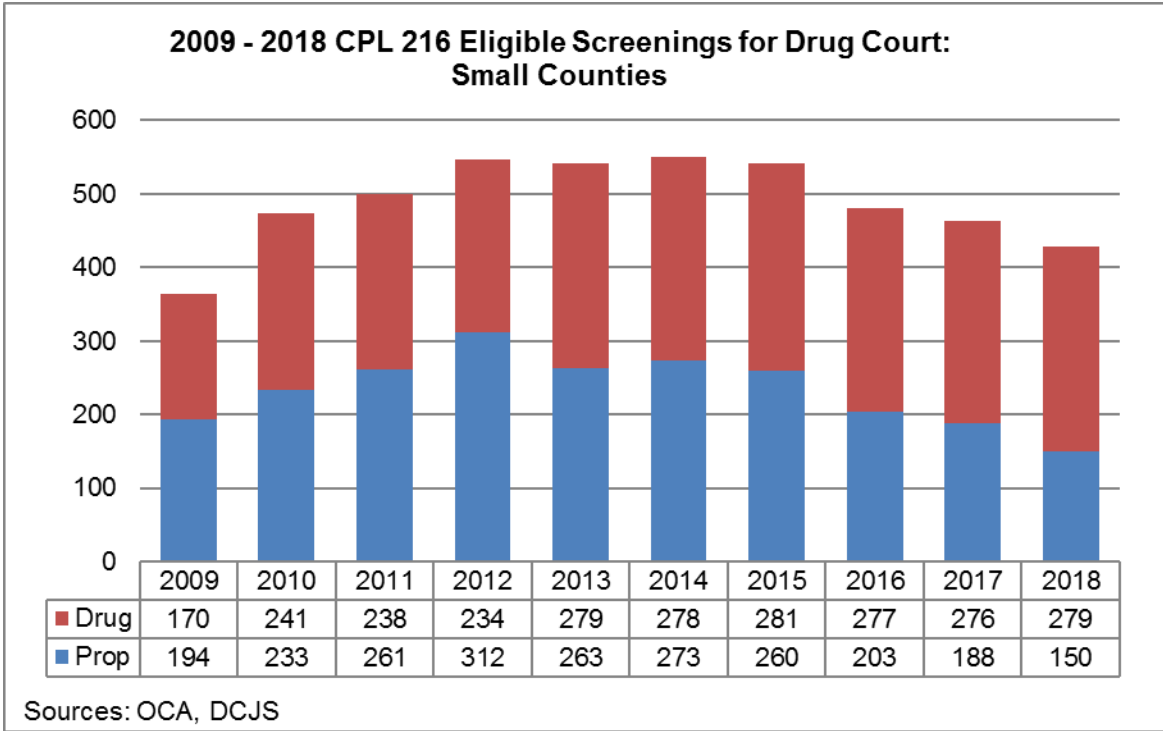
Criminal Procedure Law (CPL) Article 216: Judicial Diversion

The charts on Pages 5, 6, and 7 present screenings and admissions to felony drug court for drug and specified property offenses according to CPL Article 216. In New York City, felony drug court screenings declined from 2009 to 2018, consistent with decreases in felony drug arrests. Felony drug court admissions peaked in 2010 and declined through 2018. In large counties outside of New York City, felony drug court screenings and admissions have remained relatively stable after a spike in 2010. In small counties outside of New York City, felony drug court screenings steadily increased from 2009 to 2015 and decreased slightly through 2018. Admissions followed a similar trend. In May 2017, New York State opened the first of 16 opioid courts. The data presented here do not include screenings and admissions to those courts. It is anticipated that future reports will include opioid court activity.

Felony drug court screenings and admissions for arrests eligible for judicial diversion, by county, are presented in Appendix G and Appendix H.







Conditional Sealing

CPL Article 160.58 authorizes conditional sealing of cases for drug-involved offenders who successfully complete court-ordered substance abuse treatment. Through February 2019, 700 cases have been conditionally sealed under this provision. Cases sealed by county are presented in Appendix I. A regional summary is presented below.
