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Data Notes

The state Division of Criminal Justice Services provides funding, training and technical support to 20 police agencies and their law enforcement partners in 17 counties through the Gun Involved Violence Elimination (GIVE) initiative, which aims to reduce shootings and save lives in communities with high rates of violent and firearm-related crime.

The Albany, Binghamton, Buffalo, Hempstead, Jamestown, Kingston, Middletown, Mt. Vernon, Nassau County, Niagara Falls, Newburgh, Poughkeepsie, Rochester, Schenectady, Spring Valley, Suffolk County, Syracuse, Troy, Utica, and Yonkers police departments participate in GIVE. This report contains the following data as reported by these police departments by the 20 police agencies participating in GIVE.

Violent Crime by Firearm

These data show the number of violent crimes – murder, rape, robbery and aggravated assault – and the number and percentage of those crimes reported as involving a firearm. Data are shown annually for the past 10 years.

Note:

Police agencies began reporting the index crime of rape under the FBI's expanded definition in 2015. The FBI implemented this change to reflect the scope and volume of sexual assaults nationwide more accurately. Given this change, caution should be used when citing or interpreting percentage changes when comparing the number of rapes reported from 2015 forward with those reported in 2014 or earlier. Increases in those totals may be attributable in part to the expanded definition of rape.

The FBI's expanded definition does not apply to rapes reported as involving a firearm and as a result, these data can be compared from year to year. The firearm-related rape data include only the following Penal Law crimes: first-degree rape; second-degree rape, subsection 2; and third-degree rape, subsections 1 and 3.

Shooting Incidents, Shooting Victims, and Individuals Killed

Shooting Incidents Involving Injury or Death: Number of shooting incidents during the month where one or more persons were injured or killed as a result of the shooting.

Shooting Victims (Persons Hit): Total number of victims shot in the shooting incidents reported, including individuals killed.

Individuals Killed by Gun Violence: The number of murders resulting from firearm related injuries.
