Criminal Justice Processing Reports

How to Use these Reports

In 2018, the Division of Criminal Justice Services, Office of Justice Research and Performance (OJRP) developed a set of new reports to replace the Felony Processing Reports which DCJS had been producing and disseminating to District Attorney offices for the past two decades. With input from a workgroup of District Attorney Offices and other stakeholders, OJRP produced a series of new tables that provide information on felony case outcomes and other criminal justice trends within the county and the rest of the state. The purpose of the new report is to comply with DCJS statutory reporting requirements and better leverage available state data to aid District Attorneys with monitoring trends, workload, and performance.

This guide was produced to support District Attorney offices in utilizing the tables provided in the new report. The attached mock report from 'Sample County" provides a brief description of each table and demonstrates how the tables can be used. Below is a listing of the tables contained in the new report and questions each table can answer.

Felony Processing Point Counts - Annual Overview

What is volume of felony arrests, felony arraignments, felony convictions, and prison sentences? How has this changed over the past few years? What is the trend in the rest of the state?

Table 1, 1A, 1B – Felony and Misdemeanor Adult Arrests

What are the felony and misdemeanor arrest charges in the county and how has the volume changed over the past year? How does the county trend compare to the rest of the state?

Table 2 – Felony and Misdemeanor Adult Arrest by Age Group

What is the age of arrestees? How does this compare to the rest of the state? Has there been a change in the age of arrestees over the past year?

Table 3, 4 – Felony & Misdemeanor Adult Arrests by Arresting Agency

What is the volume of felony arrests in the county by police agency? What are the charge categories by police agency? Who makes the most arrests? Who makes the least arrests?

Table 5 – Local Criminal Court Arraignments

What is the volume of felony and misdemeanor arraignments in the lower courts? What are the arraignment charge categories by court?

Table 6 – Superior Court Felony Arraignments

What are the felony arraignment charges in Superior Court? How do they compare to last year? What is the usage of indictments versus informations?

Tables 7A, 7B, & 7C – Days from Arrest to Superior Court Arraignments

How long does it take from arrest to felony arraignment in superior court? For how many cases did superior court arraignment take less than two weeks from arrest? How many cases did superior court

arraignment take one, two, three, four or five months from arrest? How many cases were arraigned after six months from arrest? What is the median (midpoint) in the number of days from arrest to arraignment in the county? How does processing time differ between indictments and superior court informations? How does the county compare to the rest of the state?

Table 8 – Days from Superior Court Arraignment to Final Court Disposition

How long does it take from felony arraignment in superior court to final disposition? How does this differ by arraignment charge type and disposition outcome? How does this differ between indictments and SCIs? How does the time to disposition compare with the rest of the state?

Table 9, 9A – Dispositions of Felony Indictments and SCIs

How are felony cases disposed? How does this differ by arraignment charge type and indictment versus information? How does the county compare to the rest of the state?

Table 10 – Superior Court Cases Resulting in Conviction – Arraignment Charge by Conviction Charge For felony arraignments that resulted in a conviction, what was the conviction charge category? How many resulted in a conviction for the same charge category? How many resulted in a conviction for a different charge category?

Table 11 – Cases Disposed: Trial vs. Non-Trial

How many trials were there? What are the cases that go to trial by arraignment charge? How does the percentage of cases that go to trial in the county compare to the rest of the state?

Table 12 - Trial Dispositions

What were the outcomes of the trials during the year/period?

Table 13A, 13B, 13C - Sentences for Non-YO Felony Conviction by Conviction Charge

What were the sentences imposed for non-YO felony convictions? How do the sentences differ between the conviction charge? How to the sentences differ between those who had a prior felony conviction and those who did not at the time of sentencing? How do sentences imposed for felony convictions in the county compare to the rest of the state?

Table 14 - Sentences for YO Felony Adjudications by Adjudication Charge

What were the sentences imposed for Felony YO Adjudications? How do the sentences differ between the conviction charge?

Table 15 – Non-YO Sentences to Prison by Conviction Charge

How many non-YO sentences to prison were there? What were the conviction charges? How many sentences were there in the rest of the state?

Table 16 – YO Sentences to Prison by Conviction Charge

How many Youthful Offender sentences to prison were there? What were the conviction charges? How many sentences were there in the rest of the state?
