A unknown deceased female was found in West Hill Park by hikers in the early morning on June 12, 2015. The victim was wearing a dress, bound at the wrists and ankles with zip ties, and her mouth was taped shut; the victim's neck showed signs of manual strangulation.

The victim, subsequently identified as "GD," was last seen on the evening of June 10, 2015. She had been at a bar with friends but departed early by herself, never returning home that night.

The scene was processed for impression evidence and latent fingerprints with negative results. A smudged partial latent print was recovered from the tape on the victim's mouth but was determined to be insufficient for comparison. A concordant single source, male DNA profile was developed from a semen stain on the victim's dress as well as from a vaginal swab. Specimen ID 2015-0766-VS1 refers to the vaginal swab; this DNA profile is in CODIS.
