1. Can all the course material be given electronically via download or USB stick?

***Response to Question 1:*** Yes. Section 3.2 of the RFP stipulates that sufficient reference materials, in printed form **or** electronically, must be prepared for dissemination to student participants.

2. Assuming all course material must be available online and via USB stick to each student, for purposes of bid, should bidder assume 150 students per class vs the lower class of 50 students?

***Response to Question 2:*** This is an incorrect assumption as the RFP states that the reference material is acceptable in printed form or electronically.

Regarding Group 1- the training topic **Introduction to Decision Making and Human Factors for Law Enforcement** has up to 150 students per class while the training topic **Advanced Decision Making and Human Factors for Law Enforcement** has up to 50 students per class. Regarding Group 2- the training topic **De-escalation Training** has up to 150 students per class. These numbers reflect classes at full capacity.
